She obtained her PhD in mathematics from Lund University, followed by positions in the Bioinformatics Core Facility at the Swiss Institute of Bioinformatics in Lausanne, and a postdoc at the University of Zurich. Development and benchmarking of scientific software tools for analysis of biological data is another important part of Charlotte's work, and she is engaged in the Bioconductor project ([Bioconductor - Home](#)) as a package developer, secretary of the technical advisory board and co-chair of the teaching committee.
