She then did a postdoc in the Netherlands in the lab of Ton Schumacher at the Netherland Cancer Institute and the lab of Rob de Boer at Utrecht University. She studied hematopoiesis and T cell at the single cell level, mixing experimental and theoretical work. Since 2015, Leïla Perié head a group the Curie Institute in France. Her lab is interested in understanding the hematopoietic tree at the single cell level and combines different experimental and mathematical/computational approaches of single cell lineage tracing to study blood cells production. Leïla is also the head of the single cell core facility of her institute. She is the mother of 2 and spends quite some time thinking about how we do research and why. She is also involved in a program developing participatory research. **
