### **Eliane Piaggio**

My research has been focused in the field of immunopathology and immunotherapy for more than 20 years, with an expertise in T cell biology. I obtained a degree in biochemistry and a PhD in Immunology at the National University of Rosario. I did my postdoctoral studies in France and I am currently Research Director at INSERM. I direct the "Translational Immunotherapy Team" at the Institut Curie in Paris, and our team is part of the First French Cancer Immunotherapy Center. My main contributions have been in the field of regulatory T cell-based immunotherapy applied to infectious diseases, autoimmunity, transplantation, and more recently, cancer. My team is interested in the development of new immunotherapies, applicable to patients, using massive single cell sequencing techniques. I am co-founder of Egle-Therapeutics, a biotechnology company developing Treg-based immunotherapies. I have mentored more than 50 students from many different horizons, teaching them how to combine research, training, and knowledge exchange in an open collaborative frame where ethics and environment are respected, which is one of my main and most appreciated missions as women in science.
